Head Boys JV Lacrosse Coach

Lakeside School, an independent coeducational day school located in North Seattle, is currently recruiting for a **head boys JV lacrosse coach** for the 2012 spring season. This position will be part-time and seasonal, with in-season coaching duties running from February 13, 2012 to the end of the spring lacrosse season.

Responsibilities:

The head boys JV lacrosse coach, reporting to the athletic director, will join an athletic program that includes 24 varsity teams, most of which have both sub-varsity and middle-school counterparts. The boys lacrosse program includes varsity and JV squads at the Upper School, as well as a single team for 7th and 8th grades. The head boys JV lacrosse coach is directly responsible for the coaching of the JV team as well as other duties within the program as assigned by the head boys varsity lacrosse coach. Specific responsibilities include:

- Compliance with all Lakeside School and WHSBLA policies and procedures;
- Supervision and instruction of student-athletes during all team activities;
- Attendance at required boys lacrosse program and Interscholastic Athletics Program meetings;
- Maintenance and inventory of program equipment and apparel;
- Support of multi-sport participation for student-athletes; and
- Promotion of balanced achievement in all areas of school life for student-athletes.

Requirements:

Successful candidates must be at least 19 years of age, possess a valid Washington State driver's license, and be available for afternoon practices and some weekend practices/competitions during their coaching season. Previous experience coaching boys lacrosse at the high school, club, or collegiate level is preferred, but not required. Candidates must also satisfactorily complete a criminal background check.

Salary & Benefits:

Lakeside School is committed to attracting and retaining outstanding coaches through a stipend schedule that compares favorably with those of peer schools and clubs both locally and nationwide. Coaching stipends are paid in monthly installments during the primary competition season. Other benefits include Lakeside Athletics apparel and access to funds for professional development.
